

Can you sponsor a slate and help to secure the future of a community facility for all?

The former St John's School was opened in 1861 in the building on the corner of Scotgate and West Street, now the All Saints' and St John's Centre. An important Victorian Gothic building, with a Collyweston Slate roof, the building plays an important role in the entrance to the Stamford Conservation Area. The Centre is used by many organisations locally and we are on a fundraising journey to help the rooms be of greater benefit to the community in the future.



What do we need? - Our initial target is 3000 slates for the South Elevation (total cost £40,000)

Our first priority is to ensure that the building is weatherproof by undertaking essential roof repairs to the Collyweston slate roof. Collyweston slate is traditionally measured in 'squares', a square being the amount of slate needed to cover an area 10ft x 10ft. The current price per square is c.£1000 - £1500. Approx. 6 squares will be needed for the shortfall on the South elevation and approx. 18 squares for the whole roof, with each square containing between 300 and 600 slates.

How you can help

You can sponsor an individual slate for £10 or £1500 for a square of slates.
